Comments

This data summary provides a baseline for the data being collected by the HNCMA foreshore cleanup program. Data collection using the Tangaroa Blue Foundation methodology began in October 2012. The aim of these data summaries is to complement the program's activity reports with statistical information on the items recovered from the river for the purpose of identifying sources of debris and identifying mitigation measures. Future data summaries will be produced on a quarterly basis and additional details of individual cleanup sites are available on request to project partners. Comments and suggestions on the content and presentation of the program's data are welcome.











Cleanup sites have been grouped into the four areas shown in the map above. The top 10 items and percentage of materials for each area are shown in the following graphs and cover the period from October 2012 to March 2013. Further descriptive detail of the effort and logistics involved in these cleanups is available in the activity reports produced by Graham Johnston. These reports date back to the projects beginning and reflect the quantity and volume of debris removed from the river to date and the huge effort provided by the schools and groups engaged by the project.

Although there may be a small amount of marine debris incursion in the lower Hawkesbury this is disregarded as most of the debris is assumed to be sourced from the river surrounds and activities.

Items originating from the oyster farming industry do not show up in the data for the period covered in this summary but do constitute a significant volume of debris over time. Oyster farmers are actively supporting the project in the removal of these items through hire of boats and the volunteering of their time.


