

From 31 May 2015, geotechnical investigations to inform detailed design of NorthConnex will take place at night along the on and off ramps of the Hills M2 Motorway in Pennant Hills. This work will take around four weeks to complete.

This work will involve:

- Creating a test pit in the roadway and taking core samples
- Excavating a borehole 300m in diameter
- Repairing the road.

Plant and equipment includes drill rigs, water carts, vacuum truck, lighting towers and hand tools for compacting and repairing the road.

To minimise the impact on motorists work will occur outside of peak hours from 9pm to 5am. Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Electronic arrow boards will be in place to advise the changes to traffic conditions.
