

COMMUNITY BANNERS

Exempt and Complying Development Control Plan permits without consent the display of short term temporary community banners to attract public support for social, cultural and recreational events. The requirements for exempt community advertising are as follows:

- (a) *The banner is for a social, cultural or recreational event.*
- (b) *The banner advertises the event or activity only.*
- (c) *The maximum area of the banner is 4m².*
- (d) *Sponsorship information is a maximum of 20% of the total area of the banner displayed at the venue or the sponsor's premises.*
- (e) *The banner is erected a maximum of 28 days before the event.*
- (f) *The banner is removed within 7 days following the event.*
- (g) *A maximum of 6 banners are erected in association with the event at separate locations including the venue.*
- (h) *The banner is not attached to a tree.*
- (i) *The banner is erected in an area designated by Council as suitable for the display of banners.*
