Get involved at the Nursery

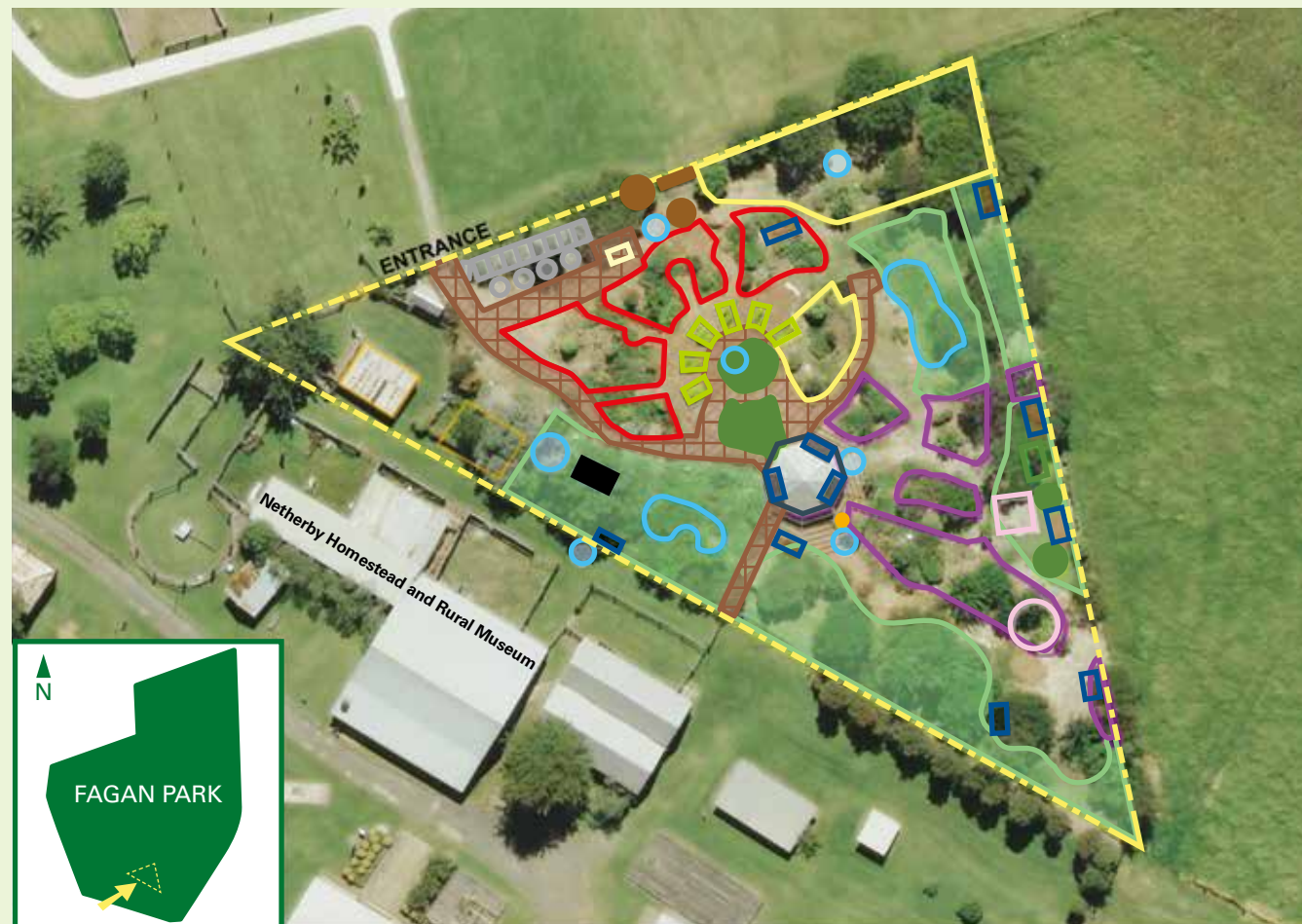
- Come along to the Pennant Hills Nursery
