Grab yourself a bargain!



Information for households participating in Second Hand Saturday

What you need to do to get ready for your sale:

- Identify items that you no longer want, collect them in preparation for the day, and identify and/or label them with a price. Remember to price your items realistically. Some items may even be free
- Identify a suitable and visible site within your property boundary such as the driveway or front lawn where items to be given away or sold are to be placed
- Ensure your items are presentable - they may need a wipe over or a clean if they have been out of use for a while
- Ensure you have enough change on the day, particularly small notes and coins

On the morning of your sale:

- Display the posters available on Council's website to attract people to your garage sale. You can add your address onto the poster to direct people to your house
- Place the items you are giving away or selling in the location where you are holding your sale
- Display items for sale by:
 - Grouping similar items e.g. Kitchen wares, games and tools
 - Group items with similar pricing e.g. 'Nothing over \$5'
 - Hanging or folding clothes
 - Place items which are free at the entrance to your sale area with a big 'free' sign
 - Plug in electrical items to show they work
- Plan to be there to keep an eye on what is happening and to meet local fossickers
- Be prepared to bargain

Packing up:

- Place all paper signs in your yellow lid recycle bin
- Separate items which can go to charities or op shops, or be advertised on www.freecycle.org.au
