**Re: Planning Proposal to implement the Hornsby Housing Strategy**

I am writing in response to your Council's letter of 8 December 2009 requesting a Gateway Determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ('EP&A Act') in respect of the planning proposal to implement the Hornsby Housing Strategy by amending the Hornsby Local Environmental Plan 1994 to rezone certain precincts to permit multi unit housing, and to insert a new zone to facilitate five storey multi unit housing and insert density provisions.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway Determination.

The Gateway Determination requires that the planning proposal be made publicly available for a period of 14 days. Under section 57(2) of the Act I am satisfied that the planning proposal is in a form that can be made available for community consultation.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 6 months of the week following the date of the Gateway Determination.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under s54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

## Gateway Determination

**Planning Proposal (Department Ref: PP\_2009\_HORNS\_002\_00):** to implement the Hornsby Housing Strategy by amending the Hornsby Local Environmental Plan 1994 to rezone certain precincts to permit multi unit housing, and to insert a new zone to facilitate five storey multi unit housing and insert density provisions.

I, the Director General as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Hornsby Local Environmental Plan 1994 to rezone certain precincts to permit multi unit housing, and to insert a new zone to facilitate five storey multi unit housing and insert density provisions should proceed, subject to the following conditions:

1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
  - (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in *A Guide to Preparing LEPs* (Department of Planning 2009) and must be made publicly available for **14 days**; and
  - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 4.5 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs* (Department of Planning 2009).
2. Consultation is required with the following agencies under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act:
  - (a) Department of Environment Climate Change and Water
  - (b) Department of Transport and Infrastructure
  - (c) Department of Education and Training
  - (d) Roads and Traffic Authority
  - (e) Department of Housing
  - (f) Department of Health
  - (g) State Emergency Services
  - (h) NSW Rural Fire Service
  - (i) Origin Energy
  - (j) Integral Energy
  - (k) Transport Infrastructure Development Corporation

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material. Each public authority is to be given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal, or to indicate that they will require additional time to comment on the proposal. Public authorities may request additional information or additional matters to be addressed in the planning proposal.

3. No public hearing is to be held into the matter under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act.
4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **6 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
