REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic and parking implications of proposed 'Bus Zone' signs at Pretoria Parade between boundary of 34 and 36 Pretoria Parade, and between boundary of 27 and 29 Pretoria Parade. These two bus stops are currently operating and this proposal is to regulate them.

SUBJECT

Council's traffic rangers have identified ongoing illegal parking occurring at the bus stops in Pretoria Parade. It has been reported that some drivers who are unaware of the road rules often park at the bus stops forcing buses to stop in the roadway to pick up passengers.

To address the issues it is proposed to regulate two bus stops at Pretoria Parade between boundary of 34 and 36 Pretoria Parade, and between boundary of 27 and 29 Pretoria Parade. The details of the bus zones are shown on attached drawing LTC 05/2019.

CONSULTATION

Regulating existing bus stops will not have any adverse impact to the community or the bus company. There will be no loss of on-street parking as the Australian Road Rules prohibit parking at bus stops. It is recommended that nearby residents be informed of the approval before installation.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

- 1. Two bus zones (approximately 30.5 metres long at the north side and 30 metres long at the south side) are to be installed at Pretoria Parade between boundary of 34 and 36 Pretoria Parade, and between boundary of 27 and 29 Pretoria Parade as per plan No LTC 05/2019.
- 2. Residents in the immediate area be notified of LTC's recommendation.
