CAT LIFETIME REGISTRATION AND FEE INFORMATION



The NSW Government require the owners of dogs and cats to pay a lifetime registration fee before their pet is 6 months of age. The purpose of the following information is to help you understand how to register your pet and what fee/s you will need to pay.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR PET

You can register your pet by creating a profile on the NSW Office of Local Government website: **petregistry.nsw.gov.au** and 'claiming' your pet.

Please ensure you are on this website to pay the lifetime registration fee as there are a number of privately run databases that appear in search engines.

ANNUAL PERMIT

In addition to lifetime registration on the 1 July 2020 the NSW Government introduced an annual permit fee for cats not desexed by the age of 4 months.

- If your cat is desexed after 4 months of age, you will need to pay an \$92 annual permit fee for one year only
- If your cat is not desexed you must pay an \$92 annual permit fee

Desexed (eligible pensioner)	\$32
Desexed (after 4 months of age) An annual permit fee of \$92 is applicable.	\$65
Not desexed An annual permit fee of \$92 is applicable.	\$65
Not desexed (not recommended) If your vet is unable to update the pet register, a letter from a vet must be submitted to council prior to the cat being 4 months of age stating that the cat should not be desexed at all or should be desexed at a later stage. You must provide a desexing certificate by the date the vet has stated, if you desexed your cat after that date you must pay the permit fee.	\$65
Not desexed (recognised breeder)	\$65

Please be advised that a late fee of \$21 is applicable if you do not pay the registration fee for your cat within 28 days after the date on which the animal is required to be registered.
