SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed temporary 'Works Zone' in Rivertop Close, Normanhurst, to accommodate the construction of: RESIDENTIAL - TWO STOREY DWELLING - SEPP CONTROLS.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from Clarendon Homes for a temporary 'Works Zone' at the frontage of 2 Rivertop Close, Normanhurst. The building works are in accordance with: Approved Complying Development Certificate - Private - CDP/239/2022.

The proposed 10 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 27 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontage will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.
