



Ruddock Park Upgrade – Construction Commencing

In August/September 2021 plans were placed on public exhibition indicating proposed upgrade works at Ruddock Park, Westleigh. The park upgrade works proposal was supported and construction works are about to commence.

The Ruddock Park upgrade is being proudly funded by the NSW Government's Public Spaces Legacy Program (PSLP) Grant and Hornsby Shire Council.

The construction works at Ruddock Park will be implemented in two parts:

Part 1: Landscape Works & Learn-To-Ride

- A Learn-To-Ride play area.
- Pathway upgrades providing safe and inclusive shared connectivity network.
- Additional activities such a basketball half court, relocation of swings, seating/picnicking shelters, planting, lawn areas and an outdoor gym.

Part 2: Club House & Amenities Refurbishment:

- Refurbishment of club house interiors, public toilets and building roof.
- Construction of ramp and steps for the building access.
- Other building repair works as necessary.

Construction is expected be completed in April 2023 weather permitting.

The construction work will be undertaken in phases with the intension that parts of the park will be open to public with segregated construction areas fenced for safety. However, as works progress, parts of the park including the playground and some paths will be unavailable for extended periods at various times.

Pedestrian movement will be managed and alternate walking routes provided at various times throughout construction. These will be signposted on site and updated on the website. The tennis courts will be available to the tennis club users and access to the courts will be maintained.

During the clubhouse building refurbishment works, temporary public toilets will be available in the park.
