REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a proposed temporary 'Works Zone' in Rosamond Street to accommodate **Construction of a new two storey dwelling house with associated landscaping works** at 52 Rosamond Street, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request (**WKZONE**/4/2023) from the property owner for a temporary 'Works Zone' at the front boundary of 52 Rosamond Street, Hornsby.

The building works project is in accordance with approved Development Application DA/242/2023 - Construction of a new two storey dwelling house with associated landscaping works.

The proposed **12 metres long** 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of **47 weeks initially**. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontages will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.
