
In order to accommodate the 'Disabled' space without loss of parking, the area needs be rearranged as follows:

1. Adjustment and remarking of existing 4 hour parking spaces.
2. Removal of existing 'No Parking' signs.
3. Signposting of Disabled Parking space (1 hour time limit) near existing kerb ramp.

A plan of the proposed parking changes is attached.

CONSULTATION

In June 2018 Council invited comments on the proposal from residents and retailers in the area. Letters were sent to 8 occupiers and retailers. The proposal was also placed on Council's website. Letters were sent to regulatory authorities and transport providers.

No submissions were received by Council.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. One disabled parking space 5.4m long x 3.3m wide be provided at the front of the Brooklyn Community Health Centre in Brooklyn Road in accordance with plan No LTC 27/2018.
2. The remaining 90 degree 4 hour parking spaces be remarked in accordance with plan No LTC 27/2018.
