



Project Description

Following the outcome of consultation with the local community and traditional owners, Council is undertaking to upgrade the viewing platform and landscaping works adjacent the Quarter Sessions Road Engraving Site (also known as 'Blackfellows Head'), as identified in Councils Walking and Cycling Strategy.

Works include:

- Deco granite pathway (gold) with Coreten steel edging
- Minor revegetation with native ground covers and small native shrubs
- 3 x sandstone logs for seating
- Sandstone block path edging
- Signage renewal and installation of hazard and warning regulatory signs
- Continued fencing surrounding the Aboriginal Engraving site
- Split level viewing platform 20m2

Works are scheduled to be undertaken in 2 stages, weather pending.

- Stage 1: June 2022: Landscaping works including pathways and sandstone blocks.

- Stage 2: September 2022 - Viewing platform installation, signage and final landscaping
