REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications, design and outcome of public consultation for the proposed installation of a designated Electric Vehicle (EV) parking space in Dural Street Carpark, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

In May 2022 Council adopted the 'Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station on Public Land Policy'. The purpose of this Policy is to provide criteria for the provision, installation, management, maintenance and removal of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations on public land in the Hornsby Shire Local Government Area (LGA).

Following the adoption of the policy Council has been approached by Evie Networks Pty Ltd which has prepared a proposal to implement EV charging spaces in the Dural Street Carpark.

Evie proposes to install 2 x 50kW fast chargers at the Dural Street Carpark, this is a Council carpark.

Key points about the proposal:

- The chargers will be accessible to all EV drivers and will host CCS2 and CHAdeMO plugs.
- 3 x 2P car park spaces will be converted to Electric Vehicle Charging Only for 2 x electric vehicles. The 2P parking restriction will remain. The electric vehicle charging only parking restrictions will be enforceable.
- Evie Networks chargers use 100% Green Power.
- The chargers will be operated and maintained by Evie Networks by Evie's dedicated operations team.
- The cost of charging sessions will be based on kWh consumed.

Dural Street Carpark is a **51 space public carpark** where 2-hour parking restrictions apply.

Evie is **proposing to convert three (3) existing car parking bays into two (2) 'No Parking: Electric Vehicle Excepted Only While Charging' bays** (RMS Sign no. R5-41-5).

The spaces and associated infrastructure will be located in the north-western corner of the carpark, adjacent to an existing electricity sub-station.

CONSULTATION

In February 2023, 'Evie' (on behalf of Council) invited comments on the proposal from residents and occupiers within a 50 metre radius of the location. The proposal was also exhibited on Council 'Have Your Say' website. Notifications were sent to regulatory authorities.

Nineteen (19) submissions have been received during the exhibition period from residents and retailers. Eleven (11) in support and eight (8) raising other issues. Three (3) responses were also received from authorities raising no objections.

A detailed public consultation summary is attached (residents and retailers only)

CONCLUSION

A review of the location has confirmed that the site is appropriate of Electric Vehicle charging space. The proposal has the general support of the community. The provision of the space in the carpark is in accordance with the 'Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station on Public Land Policy'.
