REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed 'No Stopping' signs at the intersection of Linda Street and Muriel Street, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

Council has received requests from residents regarding the operation of the intersection of Linda Street with Muriel Street, Hornsby. The residents are concerned with illegal parking near the intersection. The intersection currently has a 'No Stopping' sign at the eastern leg in Linda Street, but the southern and western legs are not signposted. Monitoring of the location shows that illegal parking is an ongoing issue at this location and cars are frequently parked within 10 metres of the intersection. When this occurs, sight lines can be blocked for pedestrians using the kerb ramps, and for vehicles at the intersection, resulting in a negative impact on road users' safety.

To address the issue, it is proposed to formalise the signage at this intersection in accordance with **NSW Road Rules**. Three more 'No Stopping' signs will be installed on the southern leg and western leg of the intersection. In Muriel Street (eastern side) the restriction will be extended from the standard 10 metres to 14 metres. This is due to the presence of a nearby driveway to a Childcare Centre (4-6 Linda Street). Leaving a 4 metre gap near the driveway would result in cars regularly blocking the driveway to the Childcare Centre, which generates a moderate level of traffic.

CONSULTATION

Consultation for this proposal is considered not necessary as the proposed signs will generally formalise the 10 metre 'No Stopping' rules that apply to all intersections in accordance with the NSW Road Rules (Rule 770 Stopping in or near an intersection).

Nearby residents and occupiers will be notified of the installation.
