REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a Proposed Temporary Works Zone in Lockerbie Road, to accommodate landscaping works at Hawkins Hall.

SUBJECT

Council is about to commence works at Hawkins Hall in Lockerbie Road. The works will involve concrete path, playground, and blockwork wall. Parking occupancy in Lockerbie Road is moderate due to it being in a medium density area. Majority of the hall will remain open during the works, apart from the construction site, where the new assets will be installed.

Large vehicles (such as excavator, low loader truck, crane, concrete trucks) will not be able to park on this site. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontage will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site. It will also isolate heavy construction vehicles from the general parking.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site, the frontage of Council's hall.

Hall users will be informed by signs located in the park, of the upcoming works and impact on parking.

1. 55-metre long 'Works Zone 7:00am to 5:00pm, Monday-Saturday' be approved for installation at (Hawkins Hall) Lockerbie Road, Thornleigh for the duration of the construction activity, initially 8 weeks.
