NorthConnex early work activities: survey work – at night on Pennant Hills Road in Wahroonga and Normanhurst

From 31 May 2015, survey work will take place at night along sections of Pennant Hills Road, Wahroonga and Normanhurst.

This work will take about 10 nights to complete, weather permitting and will involve the closure of Pennant Hills Road (lanes 1 and 2) from Normanhurst Road to 100m north of Pacific Highway (northbound and southbound). Please see attached map (see over) for further detail.

To minimise impact on motorists work will occur outside peak times between 8pm and 5pm.

Plant and equipment for this work includes lighting towers, traffic control vehicles and signage, light vehicles, surveying tools and location mark-up paint.

Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Truck mounted variable message signs will be used on motorways to advise motorists of changes to traffic conditions. At least one lane will be maintained for access during the work.

We apologise for any inconvenience and will take steps to minimise any impact associated with this important work.
