### Important information about Bulky Waste Collection

- Residents must place their materials in the designated area.
- The maximum volume per collection for your block is three cubic metres. If you exceed this amount you will be asked to remove it.
- Small items can go in your red lid garbage bin.
- Place metal items in a separate pile for recycling.
- Make sure items can be easily lifted by two people.
- Cardboard can be put into your yellow lid recycling bin or taken to the Thornleigh Community Recycling Centre.
- Council's contractor has the right to refuse any unsuitable items.
- Remember: Placing your bulky waste out too early is considered illegal dumping.

### Household quantities of the following waste items can be dropped off at the Community Recycling Centre (CRC), 29 Sefton Road Thornleigh.

- Gas bottles and fire extinguishers
- Paints and aerosols
- Motor and other oils
- Fluro globes and tubes
- Smoke detectors and ink cartridges
- Household and car batteries
- Soft plastics and flattened cardboard
- Electronic waste and mobile phones

**Note:** White goods and general electrical appliances are not accepted.

# Your Bulky Waste Collection

If you have large household items you wish to dispose, Council provides a bulky waste collection once a month.



## Bulky waste collection for your unit block for 2019 will be:

For designated bulky waste pickup location, ask your strata manager.

**Third Thursday of each month**

## Important information about your bulky waste collection

To keep you, your neighbours and our workers safe it is important to:

- ✓ Place items on the nature strip at the front of your property **one day** only before your scheduled collection
- ✓ Place metal items in a separate pile for recycling
- ✓ Make sure items can be easily lifted by two people
- ✓ Put small items in your red lid garbage bin
- ✓ Only place **accepted items** out for collection
- ✗ The maximum volume per collection is three cubic metres (3m<sup>3</sup>). If you exceed this amount you will be asked to remove it
- ✗ **Unacceptable items** will not be collected and must be returned to your property

**Council reserves the right to refuse any item for collection**

## Items accepted for collection

- Broken and discarded furniture
- Toys and bicycles
- Appliances and fittings, including white goods (please remove the doors from refrigerators, freezers, stoves, washing machines, dryers and cupboards)
- Larger household items
- Rolled carpet and underlay (up to 12 square metres)
- Roof guttering (up to 2 metres long)
- Small metal items



Place metal items out in separate pile to enable them to be recycled.



## Items not accepted for collection

- Bushes, green waste, tree stumps and trunks
- Garbage and food waste
- Industrial, business, farm or trade waste
- Building, demolition or renovation materials
- Motor vehicle bodies, engines, tyres, batteries and parts
- Gas bottles or dangerous goods
- Concrete, bricks, rocks and dirt
- Any liquids (including paints, chemicals, oils etc.)
- Sheets of glass (with or without frames)
- Anything larger than 2 metres in length
