REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed signage and delineation at the intersection of Belmont Parade and Berowra Road, in conjunction with a Child Care Centre development at 2A Berowra Road, Mount Colah (DA/712/2017/A).

SUBJECT

Council has undertaken an assessment of the subject development application (DA/712/2017/A) being the Section 4.55(2) application. The application seeks to raise the number of children from 60 to 69, with a total of 14 off-street car parking spaces located in the basement at an existing Child Care Centre at 2A Berowra Road, Mount Colah.

The consent has been granted subject to conditions of approval (in part) requiring the proponent to install parking restrictions near the intersection of Belmont Parade with Berowra Road, and providing 'Give Way' sign and line marking to regulate the intersection.

The proponent has submitted a plan to address the above condition. Key features of the proposal are:

1. Installation of 'No Stopping' signs on each leg of intersection of Belmont Parade with Berowra Road. Locations of the signs are shown in the proposed plan.
2. Installation of a 'Give Way' sign on the approaching side of the Berowra Road to Belmont Parade.
3. Line marking for the formalised 'Give way' facility at the intersection of Belmont Parade with Berowra Road, in accordance with Transport for NSW Delineation Guidelines.

CONSULTATION

The controls at this intersection are necessary to ensure safe operation of the development. Local residents will be informed of the Local Traffic Committee approval along with conditions requiring the installation of parking restrictions and delineation.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Installation of 'No Stopping' signs on each leg of intersection of Belmont Parade with Berowra Road be approved as per plan 181241- C601.
 2. Installation of a 'Give Way' sign in Berowra Road at the intersection with Belmont Parade and associated delineation be approved as per plan 181241- C601.
