Subject: Proposed Temporary Works Zone

REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed temporary 'Works Zone' at 21-27 Station Street, Thornleigh to accommodate the Demolition of existing structures and erection of a 5 storey residential flat building comprising 38 units with a rooftop terrace and basement car park.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from Jasara Management Pty Ltd for a temporary 'Works Zone' at 21-27 Station Street, Thornleigh. The building works are in accordance with approved DA/147/2018. The proposed 30 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 52 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontage will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. 30m long "Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat" be approved for installation at 21-27 Station Street, Thornleigh for the duration of the construction activity (initially 52 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2020/2021 Fees and Charges.
