# REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

## SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed temporary 'Works Zone' in Baldwin Avenue, to accommodate the construction of 38 townhouses and basement parking at 8-18 Baldwin Avenue, Asquith.

## SUBJECT

Council has received a request from Rise Projects for a temporary 'Works Zone' opposite the site in Baldwin Avenue, Asquith. The building works project is in accordance with approved Development Application DA/124/2019.

The proposed 20 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate turning of trucks into the site during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 8 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the northern side of Baldwin Avenue (opposite side of development) will improve the turning path for heavy vehicles and minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

Plan showing proposed temporary works zone is attached.

#### CONSULTATION

As the works zone will be located <u>opposite</u> the construction site, along the side boundary of 1 Victory Street, three affected properties were <u>notified</u>.

A letter with plan was hand delivered to letterboxes on the morning of Friday 4 February 2022.

No responses have been received.

#### **RECOMMENDATION THAT**

 20m long 'Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat' be approved for installation in Baldwin Avenue, Asquith (side boundary of 1 Victory Street) for the duration of the construction activity (initially 8 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2021/2022 Fees and Charges.
