## **SUMMARY**

This report details the traffic implications, design and outcome of public consultation for the proposed installation of a designated *Electric Vehicle (EV) parking space* in Beecroft Village car park.

#### **SUBJECT**

In May 2022 Council adopted the 'Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station on Public Land Policy'. The purpose of this policy is to provide criteria for the provision, installation, management, maintenance and removal of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations on public land in the Hornsby Shire Local Government Area (LGA).

Following the adoption of the policy, Council has been approached by Jolt Charge Pty Ltd which has prepared a proposal to implement an EV charging space in the Beecroft Village car park.

Beecroft Village car park is a twenty-seven (27) space public carpark where 2-hour parking restrictions apply.

Jolt is proposing to convert one (1) existing car parking bay to "No Parking: Electric Vehicle Excepted Only While Charging" (RMS Sign no. R5-41-5).

The space and associated infrastructure will be located in the south-western corner of the carpark, adjacent to an existing electricity sub-station.

A plan of the proposal is attached.

### **CONSULTATION**

In November 2022, Jolt invited comments on the proposal from residents and tenants within a 50 metre radius of the location. The proposal was also exhibited on Council's website 'Have Your Say' between 14-21 November 2022.

The proposal has the general support of the community.

## CONCLUSION

A review of the location has confirmed that the site is appropriate for an EV charging space. The provision of the space in the carpark is in accordance with the 'Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station on Public Land Policy'.

 Installation of one (1) parking bay "No Parking: Electric Vehicle Excepted Only While Charging" (RMS Sign no. R5-41-5) in the south-western corner of the Beecroft Village car park be approved.
