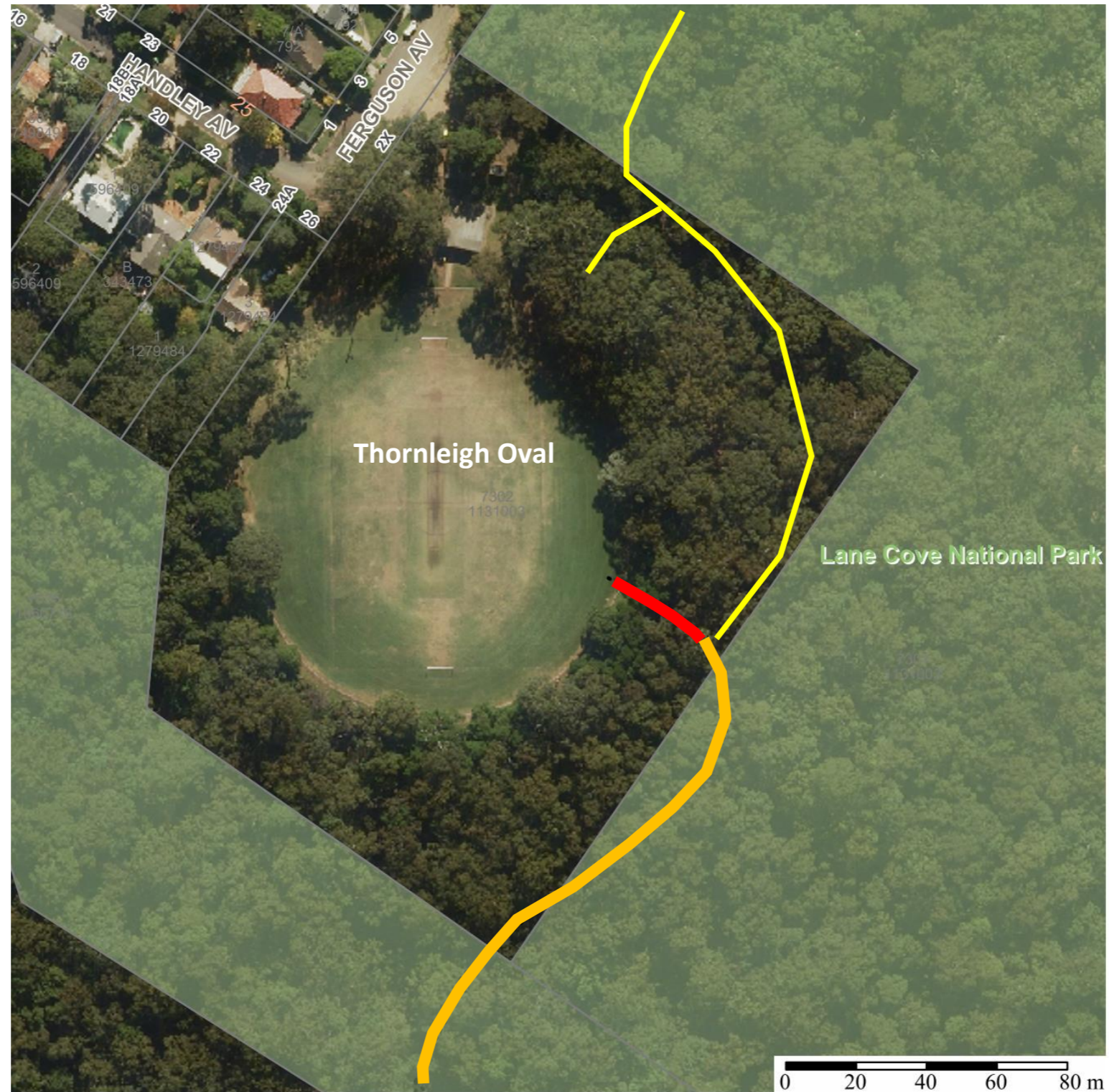




Current condition of the Great North Walk track head at Thornleigh Oval.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Overview

Council is upgrading the Great North Walk track head at Thornleigh Oval. The Great North Walk is a very popular walking track for locals and tourists. The track head at Thornleigh Park has become degraded over many years of use and is beyond general maintenance activities.

The upgrade works includes:

- Removal of existing steps.
- Installation of sandstone steps.
- Installation of drainage swale.




The upgrade works will be starting on Thursday 16th March and will be completed within 2 weeks (weather dependant).

Working hours - Monday to Friday 7am-5pm.
