The Hornsby Quarry road construction spoil management project – early work

As part of NorthConnex, the Hornsby Quarry Road Construction Spoil Management Project will provide Hornsby Quarry with excavated tunnel spoil to assist in filling the void. Once complete, Hornsby Shire Council plans to rehabilitate the site to provide a public recreational area benefiting the local community.

To prepare for site establishment and spoil haulage for this project, NorthConnex will start early site preparation work at Bridge Road and Old Mans Valley access track, Hornsby.

What are we doing?

Preparation work will take place along Bridge Road from Roper Lane to the TAFE access and along Old Mans Valley access track. The early work will provide the project team with information that will assist in design for the permanent site establishment work and for spoil haulage.

Work activities:

- Survey set out onsite
- Removal of two street lights poles on Bridge Road
- Installation of environmental controls along Bridge Road and Old Mans Valley access track
- Underground service investigation work along Bridge Road
- Temporary construction fencing set up along perimeter of construction work areas in Old Mans Valley, plus temporary barriers where required
- Vegetation removal along Bridge Road
- Vegetation removal along Old Mans Valley access track
- Geotechnical investigation along Bridge Road and Old Mans Valley access track
- Office, work amenities and laydown area set up in Old Mans Valley.

Work will start from 1 July 2016 and is expected to take up to three months to complete. This work will be completed during regular construction hours of Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturdays between 8am and 1pm.

Parking and pedestrian access will be restricted on Bridge Road while early work is carried out. Access for vehicles will be maintained on Bridge Road to Hornsby TAFE, however some delays are expected.

Pedestrian and bike access along Old Mans Valley access track will be restricted due to the geotechnical investigation works. Signage will be in place to safely direct Old Mans Valley track users.

Traffic management and signage will be in place at the corner of Bridge Road and Roper Lane to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
