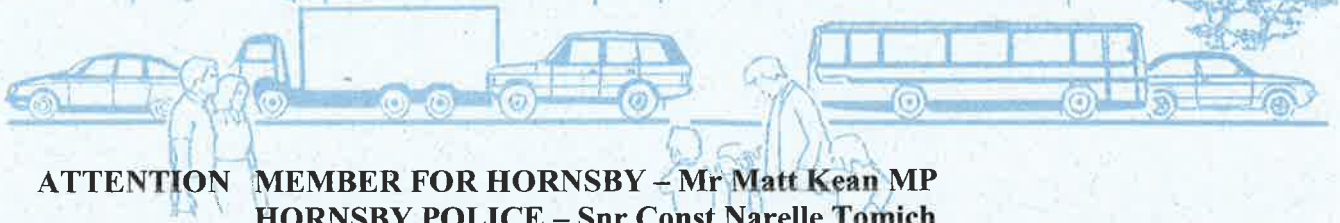

REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed temporary 'Works Zone' at No 4 Innes Avenue, Hornsby, to build a new two storey residential (single dwelling). (CDC - 8042805).

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from 'Clarendon Homes Pty Ltd' for a temporary 'Works Zone' at 4 Innes Avenue in Hornsby. The building works project is in accordance with (CDC-8042805).

The proposed 12 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 22 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontage will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site. The area proposed as a works zone is currently unrestricted.

CONSULTATION

No consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. 12m long "Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat" be approved for installation at 4 Innes Avenue, Hornsby for the duration of the construction activity (initially 22 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2018/2019 Fees and Charges.
