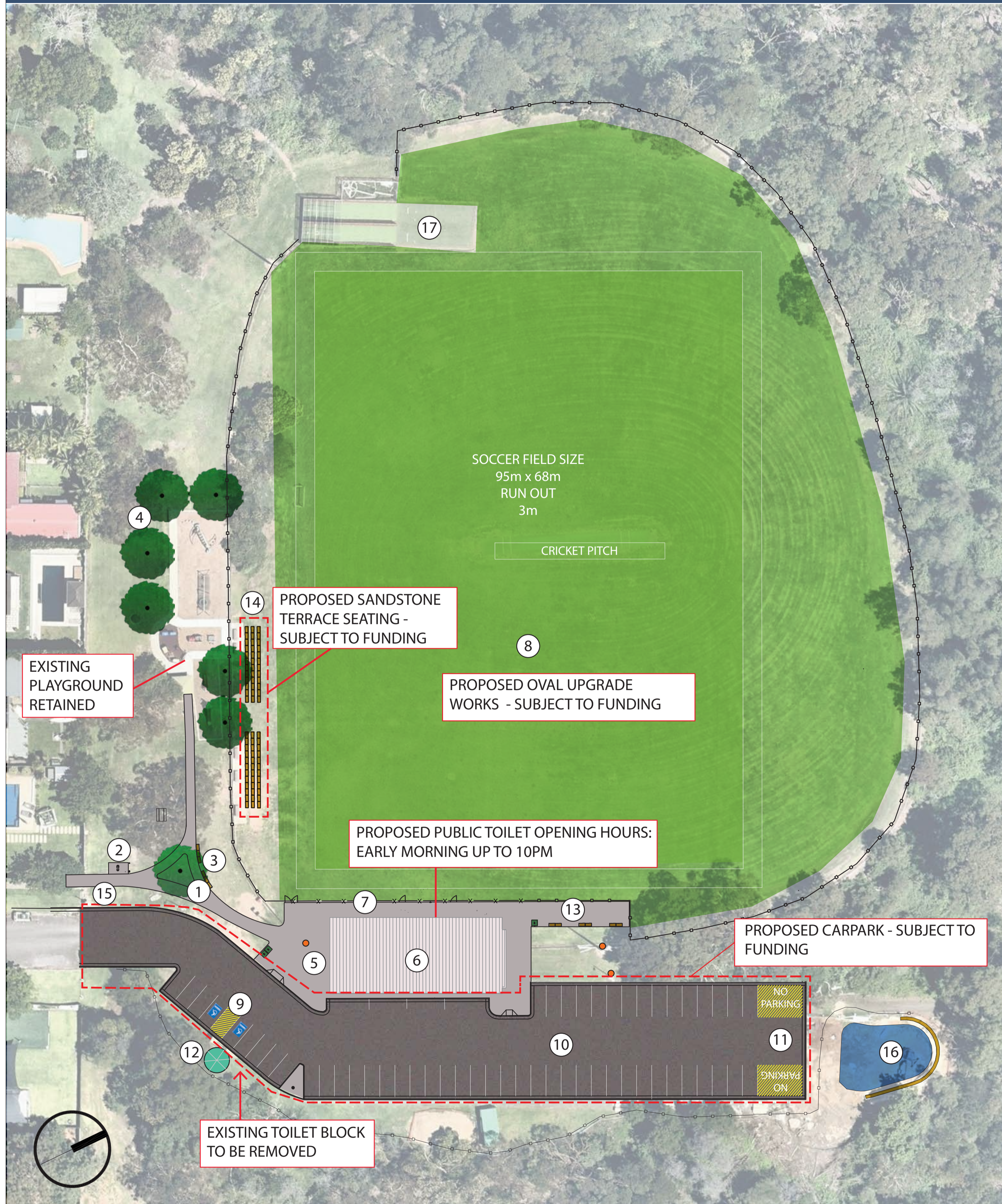


# RON PAYNE PARK & OVAL UPGRADE

Ron Payne Park at North Epping is scheduled for renewal under Council's capital works program with assisted funding by the State Government. The proposal looks to upgrade the oval's drainage by installing a new drainage and irrigation system. A new amenities building will be built to facilitate park users and sport teams with additional toilets and players with changerooms, showers, storage and canteen.

The upgrades will also provide accessible pathways to the playground and Amenity building. A proposed sandstone terrace seating within the fence area of the oval (subject to funding) will provide improved seating opportunities for park users and the existing off-leash dog area retained. A line-marked, kerbed parking is currently proposed as possible future works.

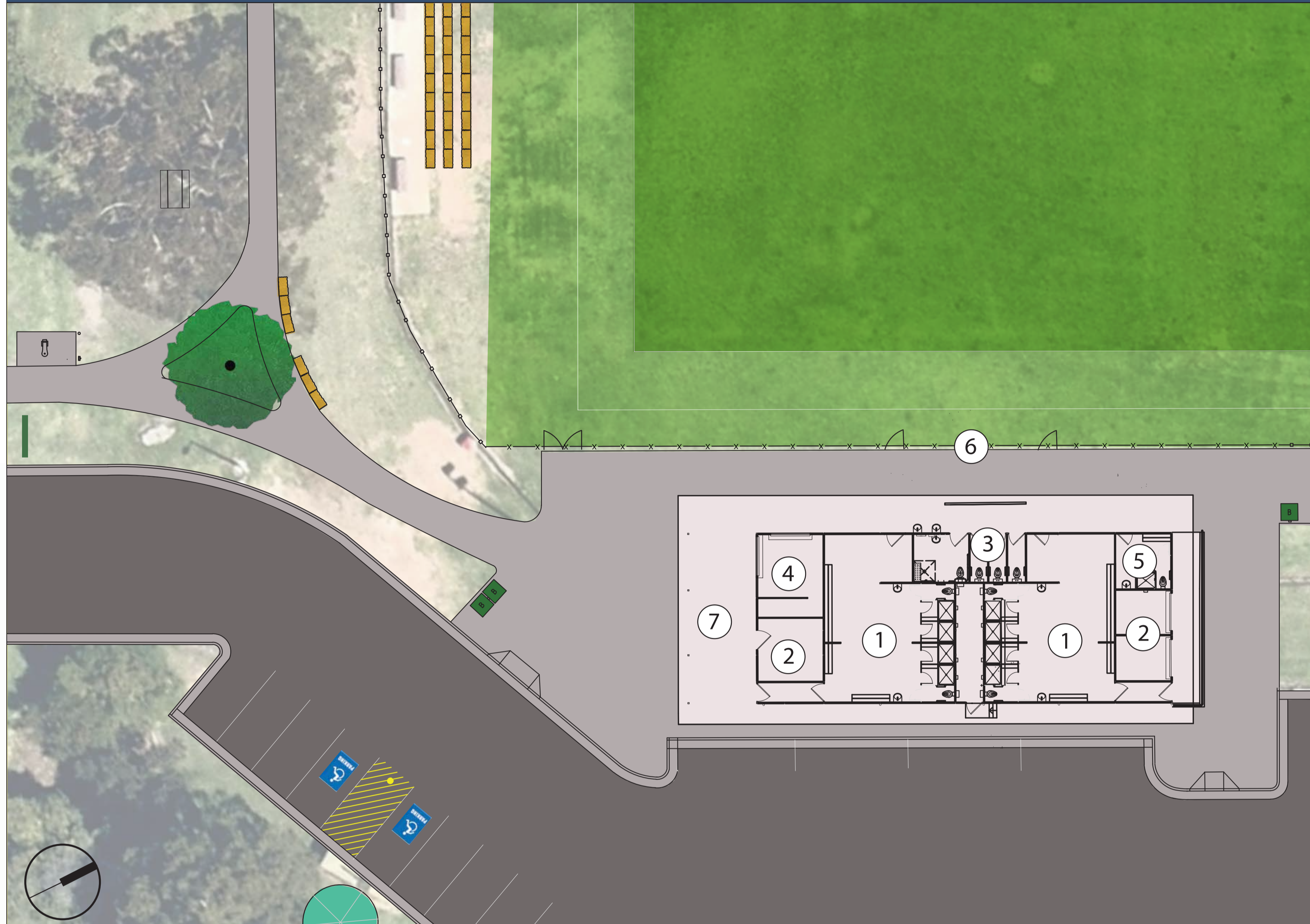

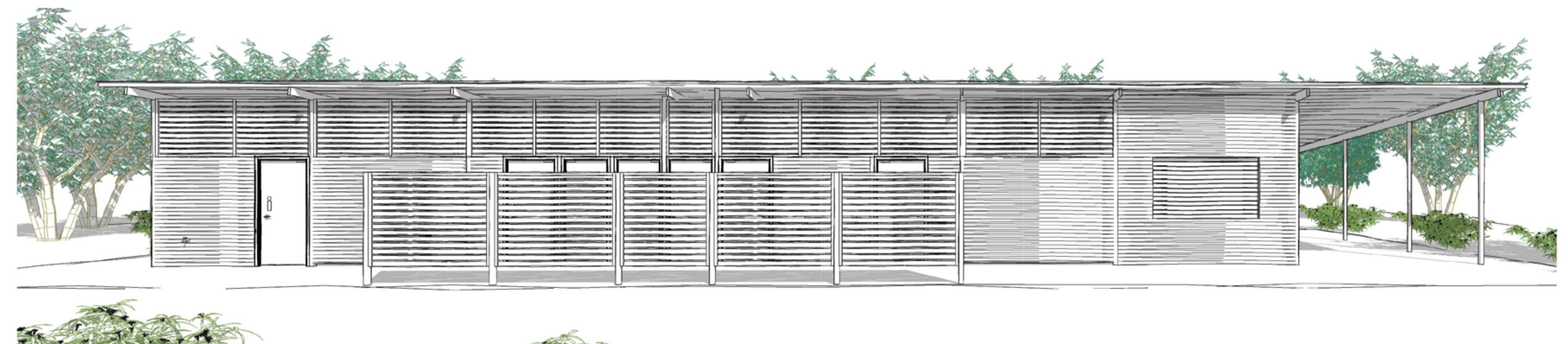
AMENITIES BUILDING
