REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic and parking implications of the installation of 'No Parking - Hornsby Shire Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted' zone at the front of Council's administration centre to accommodate Council's operational fleet.

SUBJECT

Council's Administration Centre which was temporarily re-located to Central Avenue, Thornleigh will be re-located back to its original location at the newly refurbished Administration Centre at 296 Peats Ferry Road, Hornsby. As part of a review of essential fleet vehicles, Council has identified the need to accommodate eight (8) operational vehicles at the front of the Administration Centre.

It is proposed that eight (8) existing parking spaces currently zoned as '2P 8.30am-6pm Mon-Fri, 8.30am-12.30pm Sat' be converted to 'No Parking - Hornsby Shire Council Authorised Vehicles Excepted 7am-5pm Mon-Fri'.

The existing "disabled parking" and "car share" spaces will remain unaffected.

Parking implications for the changes are considered minimal as Council's Customer Service Centre will be re-located to Hornsby Library resulting in significantly reduced parking demand at the Administration Centre. The spaces will continue to be available to the public as 'set-down and pick-up' during the operation of 'No Parking' zone and for parking outside of business hours on weekdays and all day on Saturday and Sunday.

CONSULTATION

Hornsby Shire residents and other stakeholders have been provided with regular updates about the re-location of Customer Services from Peats Ferry Road to the Hornsby Library in George Street.

Nearby retailers will be informed of the new regulations.

CONCLUSION

These parking changes are aimed at accommodating Council's operational vehicle fleet to ensure continuation of service provision for the residents. The spaces will continue to be available to the public as 'set-down and pick-up' during the operation of 'No Parking' zone, un-timed parking will be permitted outside of business hours on weekdays and all day on Saturday and Sunday.
