REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed Mambara Track Accessibility Improvements in Britannia Street, Pennant Hills, near the intersection with Kurrajong Street.

SUBJECT

Council is proposing an accessibility upgrade to the Mambara Track, as well as providing two formal accessible parking spaces alongside Britannia Street, Pennant Hills.

Key features of the proposal are:

- 1. Installation of two accessible parking bays, parallel with Britannia Street.
- 2. Upgrade existing walking track with concrete path linking to the Mambara Track
- 3. Installation of parking signs.

Plan of the proposal is attached.

CONSULTATION

Public Consultation has been conducted 22 February - 8 March 2024.

One hundred and thirty seven (137) letters were sent to affected property owners of Angophora Place, Azalea Grove, Blackbutt Avenue, Britannia Street, Cobbadah Avenue and Kurrajong Street Pennant Hills.

The proposal was exhibited on Hornsby Council's Have Your Say website for 14 days.

Fifteen (15) submissions were received during the public consultation period.

A Public Consultation Summary of the submissions and Council responses, is attached to this report.

CONCLUSION

The submissions from residents show general support for proposed parking spaces and footpath access to Mambara Track. While some submissions suggest enhancing parking enforcement for proposed disabled spaces and further extension of footpath to Kurrajong Street, Council will inform the public that the parking bays will be for disability permit holders only, any vehicles parking in the proposed bays which do not have a disability permit will be subject to enforcement by Council's Traffic Rangers. Council will consider formalising footpath to Kurrajong street pending further investigation.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

- 1. Two accessible parking spaces to be installed, including 'disabled only' parking signs in Britannia Street, north of Kurrajong Street in Pennant Hills.
- 2. Footpath access to Mambara Track to be upgraded as Plans of proposed accessible parking bay & footpath access to Mambara Track.
- 3. Nearby residents and occupiers be notified of the approval before installation.
