# **SUMMARY**

This report details the traffic and parking implications of proposed bus stops and part time "Bus Zones" at 43-45, 68, 62-64 Sherbrook Road and 2-8 Belair Close, Hornsby. The bus stops and zones are to operate between 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm School Days Only.

#### **SUBJECT**

Local transport operator 'Transdev CDC' has approached Council to implement 4 new bus stops on Sherbrook Road and Belair Close to accommodate students on a new service that is proposed for Asquith Public School. The details of the two "Bus Zones" are shown on attached drawing LTC 02/2018. Parking at the locations is unrestricted at the present time, however given recent property development in the area the part time "Bus Zones" are considered appropriate to ensure that buses can pull in close to the kerb-to-set down and pick up students.

It is proposed that the bus stops and bus zones will operate between 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm School Days Only.

## **CONSULTATION**

In October 2017, Transdev CDC consulted by letterbox drop with 75 residents affected by the proposed bus stops and bus zones including residents in new units in Belair Close.

Transdev did not receive any objections or responses to the proposal.

#### RECOMMENDATION THAT

As shown on Drawing Number LTC 02/2018:

- 1. A 20m Bus Zone be installed at the frontage of 2-8 Belair Close for 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm School Days Only.
- 2. A 21m Bus Zone be installed at the frontage of 62-64 Sherbrook Road for 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm School Days Only.
- 3. A 30m Bus Zone be installed at the frontage of 43-45 Sherbrook Road for 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm School Days Only.
- 4. A 20m Bus Zone be installed at the frontage of 68 Sherbrook Road for 8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm School Days Only.
