### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Lakes of Cherrybrook is scheduled for renewal under Council's capital works program. The proposed upgrade will improve access in and around the park through construction of concrete pathways.

The playground will be upgraded to feature a variety of play opportunities that encourage physical, social, imaginative and quiet play and be fully fenced. A climbing tower will form the focal point of the playground, acting as a visible landmark in the landscape. Nature play will be provided and there will be opportunities for swinging, sliding and rocking.

Park facilities will include new picnic shelters, seating and a drinking fountain.

Staged works may be necessary subject to funding availability.


