REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a Proposed Temporary Works Zone in New Line Road to accommodate the construction of a two-storey dwelling at 18 New Line Road, West Pennant Hills.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from Mr A Y K Chu for a temporary 'Works Zone' at the side boundary of 18 New Line Road, West Pennant Hills.

The building works project is in accordance with <u>Approved</u> CDP/1314/2021.

CDP/1314/2021 - Residential - Construction of a Two Storey Dwelling with an Attached Secondary Dwelling - Sepp Controls Complying Development Certificate - Private Principal Certifying Authority - Building Certifiers Pty Ltd Accredited Certifier - Andrew Soliman L 2 Se 49 2 O'Connell Street, PARRAMATTA NSW 2150

The proposed 11 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 28 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontages will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

 11 metres long 'Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat' be approved for installation at 18 New Line Road, West Pennant Hills for the duration of the construction activity (initially 28 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2022/2023 Fees and Charges.
