REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a Proposed Temporary Works Zone in Bridge Road, to accommodate Construction of a double storey dwelling with a detached granny flat - SEPP Controls at 41A Bridge Road, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from **Ms Yucai Zhang** for a Temporary Works Zone at the front of **39 Bridge Road**, **Hornsby (WKZONE/1/2023)**.

The Zone is associated with **construction on an adjacent property at 41A Bridge Road**, however due to other construction activities, the applicant was unable to reach agreement with property owner.

The owner of No 39 Bridge Road has agreed to the works zone being temporarily installed along their frontage to assist his neighbours.

The building works project is in accordance with approved **Complying Development Certificate - Private CDP/187/2023 (41A Bridge Road, Hornsby)**.

The proposed 10 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles' access to the site during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 14 weeks initially.

Parking occupancy in Bridge Road is very high and providing the temporary 'Works Zone', at the frontage of neighbour of the site, at 39 Bridge Road, will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

Plan showing Proposed Temporary Works Zone is attached.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required. The owner of No 39 Bridge Road has agreed to have the works zone along his frontage to assist his neighbours.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

 10 metres long 'Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat' be approved for installation at 39 Bridge Road, Hornsby for the duration of the construction activity at 41A Bridge Road (initially 14 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2022/2023 Fees and Charges.
