Night work: M1 Pacific Motorway traffic realignment, Wahroonga

Dear resident,

As part of ongoing M1 Pacific Motorway widening work, the project team will divert northbound and southbound traffic on the M1 Pacific Motorway between Pennant Hills Road and 300 metres north of Pacific Highway, Wahroonga. The traffic realignment will take place in two stages to allow us to safely build the southbound tunnel entry ramp, northbound tunnel exit ramp and noise walls.

The first traffic realignment will commence with a southbound traffic diversion from **Wednesday 25 October 2017 between 9pm and 5am**. Southbound traffic will be diverted to the new road bridge located between Pacific Highway and Pennant Hills Road. Work will be carried out in this area before northbound traffic can be diverted to the existing southbound lanes. It is expected work will take up to five weeks to complete, weather permitting.

A second traffic realignment will take place in **May 2018**. Northbound traffic will be diverted to the new northbound lane arrangement and southbound traffic will continue to use the southbound road bridge. It is expected it will take one night to complete, weather permitting.

If traffic realignment work is unable to commence as scheduled, it will commence within the following week, weather permitting.

The main work activities include installing barriers, hoarding, signage, lights and signals; traffic light modification, tree clearing, replacing noise walls, relocating services and installing drainage, constructing road pavement, concreting, asphaltting, piling, saw cutting and line marking. A map of the work area and realignment routes is provided.

Plant and equipment for this work includes cranes, excavators, bob cat, piling rigs, jack hammers, surface profilers, asphalt paving machines, heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, generators, scaffolding, rattle guns, hammer drills, grinders, concrete trucks, street sweepers, vacuum trucks, water carts and pumps, chainsaws, elevated work platforms, concrete saws and pumps, core drills, line marking and removal plant, as well as hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > Ensuring noisy work is not undertaken more than three nights in one week
- > Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > Using solar-powered lighting towers.

Traffic changes will be in place until late-2019 to allow us to complete M1 Pacific Motorway widening work, install retaining walls and noise walls, and to safely build the tunnel entry and exit ramps. Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
