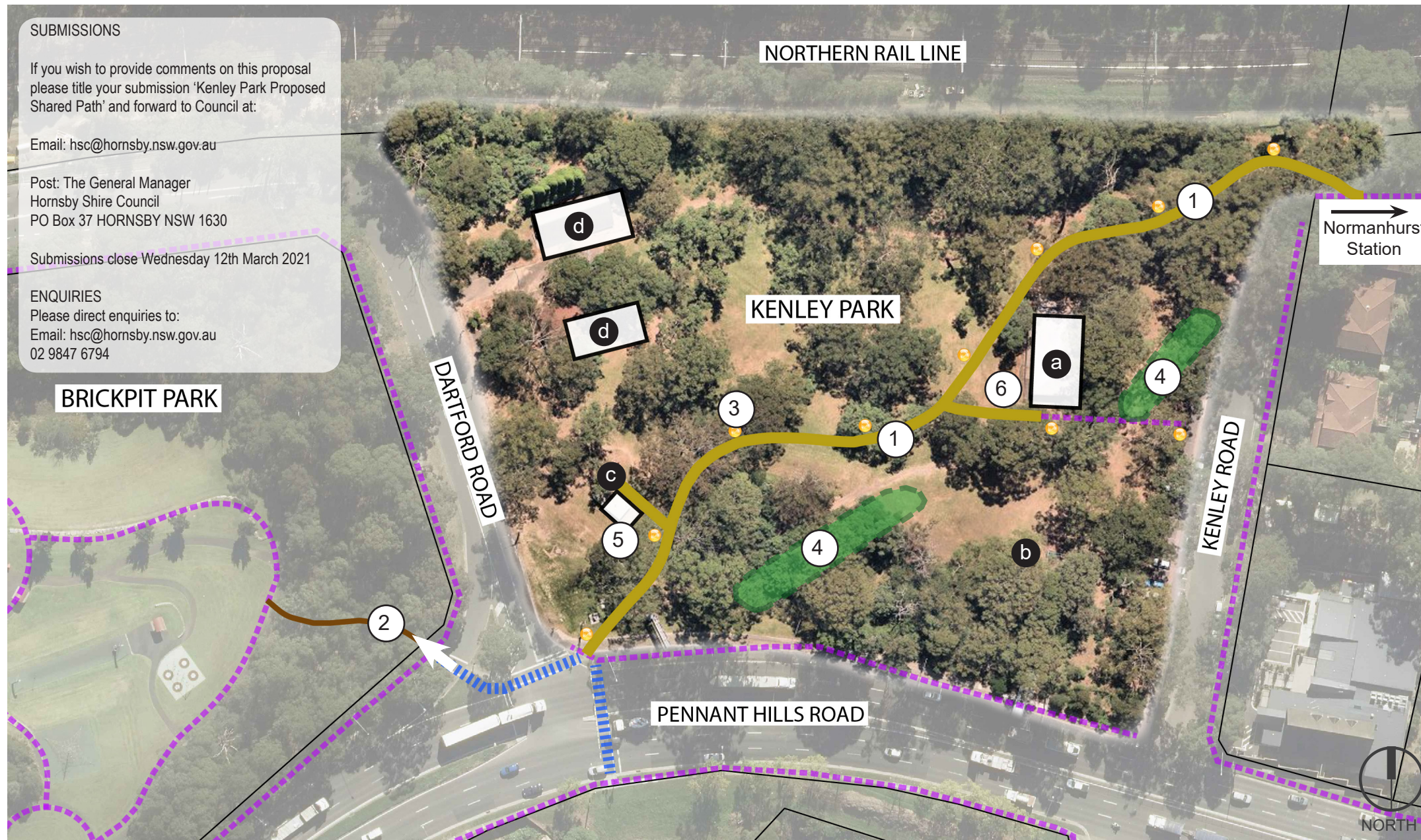

Existing Site Conditions

In the absence of designated paths, regular pedestrian movement has given way to two sets of unpaved paths cutting across the site.

This has created safety concerns for pedestrians when crossing Dartford Road and soil erosion along the unpaved paths.




Design Proposal




The Council design proposal includes:





1. A 2.5m wide concrete path connecting Normanhurst Station to the signalised pedestrian crossing on Pennant Hills Road to encourage safe movement throughout the park.
2. A new entry and path into Brickpit Park to enhance connectivity between Kenley Park and Brickpit Park.
3. Installation of pathway lights for safety.
4. Revegetating eroded informal pathways to avoid soil erosion.
5. Improved link to existing amenities building.
6. Improved access path to the Historical Society building.
