### **SUMMARY**

This report details the traffic implications of the proposed temporary changes to parking restrictions in Trebor Road, Pennant Hills, between Weemala Road and Fisher Avenue near St Agatha's Primary School.

---

**SUBJECT**

The Our Lady Help of Christians (OLHC) Primary Catholic School at Epping is being temporarily co-located to St Agatha's at Pennant Hills for the duration of the redevelopment at Epping for a period of 2 years. Council has received a request from the school to change the existing parking restrictions along the northern side of Trebor Road to accommodate an additional bus service for the school. The subject section of Trebor Road is currently signposted as part time 'No Parking'.

The proposal includes the following temporary changes to parking restrictions:

1. 'No Parking, 8:00AM-6PM, School Days' restrictions in Trebor Road to be removed (50 metres long).
2. 'Bus Zone, 8:00AM-9:30AM, 2:30-4:00PM, School Days' & '2P, 9:30AM-2:30PM, School Days' restrictions to be installed in Trebor Road, northern side between Weemala Road and the school crossing (50 metres long).
3. The parking restrictions in Trebor Road will be reviewed after redevelopment of The Our Lady Help of Christians Primary Catholic School.

Plans of the proposed parking restrictions are attached.

**CONSULTATION**

Public Consultation for the proposal was undertaken over two weeks, 30 November to 14 December 2021.

16 letters were posted to residents of Trebor Road, St Agatha's Catholic Primary School and Pennant Hills Public School.

Emails were sent to regulatory authorities, transport providers and key stakeholders including NSW Police, Transport for NSW, State Transit Authority and Transdev and CDC Hillsbus bus companies.

The proposal was also placed on exhibition on Council's website for 14 days.

No responses or objections were received within the period of public consultation.
