REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a Proposed Temporary Works Zone in Derby Road, to accommodate the construction of a two-storey dwelling house at 8 Derby Road, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from Provincial Homes Pty Ltd for a Temporary Works Zone at the front of 8 Derby Road, Hornsby.

The building works project is in accordance with approved Development Application DA/948/2021.

DA/948/2021 - Construction of a dwelling house
DA/948/2021/A - Section 4.55(1A) application to amend the approved building
CC/238/2022 - Construction of a dwelling house
Construction Certificate – Private
Principal Certifying Authority - Sbac Building Consultants & Certifiers
Accredited Certifier - Mr Matthew Ruck
34/25-33 Alfred Road, CHIPPING NORTON NSW 2170

The proposed 12 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles access to the site during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 25 weeks initially.

Parking occupancy in Derby Road is very high and providing the temporary 'Works Zone' at the frontage of the site will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

Plan showing Proposed Temporary Works Zone is attached.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

 12 metres long 'Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat' be approved for installation at 8 Derby Road, Hornsby for the duration of the construction activity (initially 25 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2022/2023 Fees and Charges.
