REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic and parking implications for proposed delineation and formalising of 'Give Way' controls in Galston, at the intersections of:

- Calderwood Road and Pine Valley Road
- Pine Valley Road and Crusader Road

SUBJECT

Council has received complaints from local residents in relation to the operation of the subject intersections. It has been reported that drivers who are not familiar with the surrounding roads often ignore the give way rules at the intersections of *Calderwood Road with Pine Valley Road* and *Pine Valley Road with Crusader Road*. Council is aware that the Crusader Union of Australia (CRU) Galston Gorge Camp & Conference Centre is an attraction which generates traffic from other parts of Sydney Metro Area. Formalising the subject intersections can improve driver awareness of intersection geometry and improve traffic flow and safety at these locations.

The Proposal:

1. Installation of 'Give Way' sign and delineation in Pine Valley Road at the intersection with Calderwood Road.
2. Installation of 'Give Way' sign and delineation in Crusader Road at the intersection with Pine Valley Road.

A plan of the proposal is attached.

CONSULTATION

The proposal has been developed following monitoring of the location. Further consultation is not required as the proposed 'Give Way' installation does not impact on parking, changes to the priority or operation of the intersections.

CONCLUSION

Formalising of the intersections with 'Give Way' signs and delineation road markings will improve driver awareness of intersection geometry and improve traffic flow and safety at these locations.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. Installation of 'Give Way' sign and delineation in Pine Valley Road at the intersection with Calderwood Road be approved as per plan LTC 08 2022.
 2. Installation of 'Give Way' sign and delineation in Crusader Road at the intersection with Pine Valley Road be approved as per plan LTC 08 2022.


