REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed changes to parking restrictions in Peats Ferry Road between Bridge Road and Jersey Lane, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

As the population of Hornsby Shire increases, changes to parking management in local streets are required to ensure adequate levels of short-term parking is maintained for customers of local businesses and visitors to residential apartments.

Council undertook parking surveys of the area, which indicated that the existing unlimited parking along Peats Ferry Road is longer efficient and that time restriction to encourage parking turnover would benefit the wider community. These changes are aimed at providing further parking options for those visiting nearby units or businesses. The following parking restriction are proposed along the <u>eastern side</u> of Peats Ferry Road:

- 1. Peats Ferry Road between Bridge Road and Jersey Lane change existing unlimited parking to 1 hour 8.30am-6pm Mon-Fri, 8.30am-12.30pm Sat.
- 2. Peats Ferry Road south of Bridge Road reduce the length of existing 'No Parking' by 10 metres. This will create additional 2 car spaces (1P).
- Peats Ferry Road at intersection with Jersey Lane change existing 'No Parking' to 'No Stopping'. This is to
 ensure that cars do not stop near the intersection.
 (Stopping near intersection is prohibited by the road rules).

CONSULTATION

In April 2023, Council invited comments on the initial proposal from residents, tenants, transport providers and authorities. 47 letters were sent to residents and 12 letters to authorities. The proposal was also placed on Council's website for 14 days.

During the consultation twelve (12) submissions were received by Council. A summary of the issues raised, with responses, is attached with this report. Copies of the submissions are available upon request.

CONCLUSION

The submissions from residents and retailers have been addressed in the attached Summary of Consultation Report. The responses from the community show majority support for the parking changes in Peats Ferry Road. Suggestions made by residents relate to commuter parking, enforcement matters, parking at other locations and changes to speed limits.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

- 1. One hour (1P) parking restriction in Peats Ferry Road between Bridge Road and Jersey Lane from (8.30am-6pm Mon-Fri, 8.30am-12.30pm Sat) be approved as per Plan No LTC14/2023.
- 2. The installation of 'No Stopping' zone in Peats Ferry Road near Jersey Lane be deferred, and the zone be installed in conjunction with future works in Jersey Lane.
- 3. The turnover of the new parking restrictions (1P) be monitored, and duration adjusted to two hour (2P) parking if occupancy is low.
