SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed temporary 'Works Zone' at No 61 Palmerston Road, Hornsby, to build a new residential dwelling. (CDP/1005/2018).

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from 'Metricon Homes Pty Ltd' for a temporary 'Works Zone' at 61 Palmerston in Hornsby. The building works project is in accordance with CDP/1005/2018.

The proposed 12 metre long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 16 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontage will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site. The area proposed as a work zone is currently unrestricted.

CONSULTATION

No consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT
