REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the parking implications for the proposed '3P, 8AM – 6PM, Mon-Fri' parking restrictions at the 90° angled parking along Galston Library frontage on Galston Road, Galston.

SUBJECT

Galston Library is located on Galston Road with approximately ten on street angled parking spaces (unmarked) for customers/visitors. Council has identified residents are parking outside the library all day.

Due to concerns where parking at the library frontage is no longer available for customers and visitors, Council's Manager Library and Information Services has requested that parking restrictions be provided to prevent all day parking.

The following restrictions are proposed:

1. Installation of 33m long section of '3P, 8AM – 6PM, Mon-Fri' and '90° Angle Parking, Front or Rear to Kerb' along the frontage of No. 359 and Galston Library.

The introduction of 3 hour parking at the library frontage is likely to displace all day parking to other locations in Galston and allow parking in close proximity for customers/visitors of the library.

CONSULTATION

In March 2018, Council invited comments on the proposal from residents and library staff. Letters were sent to regulatory authorities and transport providers. The proposal was also placed on exhibition on Council's website for 14 days.

No written responses were received from residents and library staff.

CONCLUSION

The provision of 3 hour parking restrictions at the on street parking along Galston library frontage of Galston Road will provide customer/visitor parking for the library and prevent all day parking.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. 33m long section of '3P, 8AM – 6PM, Mon-Fri' and '90° Angle Parking, Front or Rear to Kerb' be installed along the frontage of No. 359 and Galston Library in accordance with plan No. LTC 12/2018.
