# **SUMMARY**

This report details the parking implications of the proposed temporary "Works Zone" in Unwin Road, Hornsby, to accommodate construction of a sporting facility for Barker College.

### **SUBJECT**

Council has received a request from "Ford Civil Contracting" for a temporary "Works Zone" and "No Stopping' zone in Unwin Road, Hornsby. The construction activity is associated with approved construction of new sporting facility at Barker College.

# It is proposed that:

- 1. 10m 'Works Zone 7am 5pm, Monday-Saturday' be provided along the western side of Unwin Road, adjacent to the construction site access.
- 2. 10m 'No Stopping' zone be provided along the eastern side of Unwin Road opposite the site access driveway to accommodate swept path of construction vehicles.

The areas affected by proposal are currently unrestricted. Parking demand in the area is generally high due to parking by commuters, staff and students from Barker College. Providing the temporary 'Works zone' and 'No Stopping' restrictions along the site's frontage will minimise disruptions to traffic when delivery vehicles arrive at the construction site.

## PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The temporary "Works Zone" and "No Stopping" zone in Unwin Road are essential to enable construction of Barker College sporting facility approved by Council in accordance with DA/275/2017.

### RECOMMENDATION THAT

- 1. 10m long 'Works Zone 7am 5pm, Monday-Saturday' be approved for installation along the western side of Unwin Road, adjacent to the construction site access for the duration of the construction activity.
- 3. 10m 'No Stopping' zone be approved for installation along the eastern side of Unwin Road opposite the site access driveway for the duration of the construction activity.
