
SUBJECT

Transdev (TDNSW) has identified a road safety issue at bus stops ID 208136 and 208137 on Pacific Highway in Brooklyn. The stops are part of school service 592. At present time school children who are dropped off at bus stops along the highway need to walk across the highway and service lane in Kangaroo Point to reach Kangaroo Point Ferry Stop.

The proposal is to eliminate these conflicts between pedestrians and vehicles on Pacific Highway. Key features of the proposed modification include:

- School route 592 at Bus Stops ID 208136 – change location of bus stop from Pacific Highway to the existing ‘Bus and coaches only’ parking area located at Kangaroo Point carpark.
- Bus route 592 at Bus Stops ID 208137 – relocated the bus stop from its current location to the south of the intersection with Kangaroo Point Road.

A detailed risk assessment of the proposal prepared by Transdev NSW is attached.

CONSULTATION

The proposed School route 592 at Bus Stops ID 208136 will be located at Kangaroo Point which is under Council’s jurisdiction. Council’s Manager of Parks and Recreation has expressed support for the limited operation of school bus service in the carpark on a 12 month trial basis.

Bus Stop ID 208137 is located on the Pacific Highway (state road). The Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is responsible for maintenance and operation of all state roads on the NSW road network. The RMS has indicated its support for the relocation of the bus stop.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. School route 592 at Bus Stops ID 208136 be relocated from Pacific Highway to ‘Bus and coaches only’ parking area at Kangaroo Point for a 12 month trial in accordance with Transdev ‘Detailed Risk Assessment Form’.
2. RMS considers relocating bus route 592 at Bus Stop ID 208137 from its current location on Pacific Highway to the south of the intersection with the access road to Kangaroo Point in accordance with Plan No. LTC 18/2019.
