REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed temporary 'Works Zone' at the rear of No 266-268 Pennant Hills Road, Thornleigh, to accommodate construction of an approved mixed retail and shop top housing units. (DA/590/2016)

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from 'Trinity Constructions Pty Ltd' for a temporary 'Works Zone' at the rear of No 266-268 Pennant Hills Road, Thornleigh. The works zone will be installed along Railway Parade. The construction activity is associated with approved demolition of existing structures and construction of an 11 storey tower building comprising 57 residential units, 6 retail units and 3 level basement car park for 73 vehicles.

The proposed 26 metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 40 weeks initially. The rear of the site is currently subject to 1 hour parking restrictions. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontage will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

The lost short term parking can be accommodated by temporarily extending (by 4 spaces) the 1P restriction in Railway Parade, western side, north of Bellevue Street.

CONSULTATION

No consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

- 26m long "Works Zone 7am-5pm, Mon-Sat" be approved for installation at rear of No 266-268 Pennant Hills Road, Thornleigh (eastern side of Railway Parade), Thornleigh, for the duration of the construction activity (initially 40 weeks) in accordance with Council's Fees and Charges.
- 2. Four "1P 8:30am 6pm Mon Fri, 8:30am 12:30pm Sat" spaces be provided in Railway Parade, western side, north of Bellevue Street for the duration of the construction activity.
