### **SUMMARY**

This report details the traffic implications for proposed delineation and formalising of 'Give Way' controls at the T-intersection of Moores Road with Cairnes Road, Glenorie.

---

**SUBJECT**

Council has received complaints from local residents in relation to the operation of the intersection of Moores Road with Cairnes Road, Glenorie.

The intersection currently operates as a give way under the T-Intersection rule:

**ROAD RULES 2014 - REG 73****Giving way at a T-intersection****73 Giving way at a T-intersection**

**(1) A driver at a T-intersection without traffic lights or a stop sign, stop line, give way sign or give way line, must give way in accordance with this rule.**

It has been reported that drivers who are not familiar with the surrounding roads often ignore the give way rules at the subject intersection. Formalising the intersection can improve driver awareness of intersection geometry and improve traffic flow and safety at the location.

**The Proposal:**

Installation of 'Give Way' sign and delineation in Moores Road at the intersection with Cairnes Road, Glenorie.

A plan of the proposal is attached.

**CONSULTATION**

The proposal has been developed following monitoring of the location. Further consultation is not required as the proposed 'Give Way' installation does not impact on parking, and does not make changes to the priority or operation of the intersection.

**Nearby residents will be informed of the intersection treatment.**

**CONCLUSION**

Formalising of the intersection with 'Give Way' signs and delineation road markings will improve driver awareness of intersection geometry and improve traffic flow and safety at this location. As there will be no change to the operation of the intersection priority, consultation is not required.

**RECOMMENDATION THAT**

1. Installation of 'Give Way' sign and delineation in Moores Road at the intersection with Cairnes Road, Glenorie be approved as per plan No LTC 30/2023.
