REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a proposed temporary 'Works Zone' in Sherbrook Road to accommodate the construction of a new single storey dwelling at 1/125 Sherbrook Road, Asquith.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from the property owner for a temporary 'Works Zone' at the front boundary of 1/125 Sherbrook Road, Asquith. The building works project is in accordance with approved DA/1035/2022 - Demolition of an existing dual occupancy (detached) and construction of a dual occupancy (detached).

The proposed **8 metres long** 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of **24 weeks initially**. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontages will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

 8m long 'Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat' be approved for installation at 1/125 Sherbrook Road, Asquith for the duration of the construction activity (initially 24 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2023/2024 Fees and Charges.
