REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of the proposed installation of BB and S1 lines on Cobah Road between Perry Road and Northholm Grammar School in Fiddletown. The new delineation is aimed at improving driver behaviour along the newly reconstructed section of Cobah Road.

(Northholm Grammar School, 79-81 Cobah Road, Fiddletown)

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from residents of Cobah Road to install road delineation, to ensure cars and busses travelling to / from the nearby school, keep on the left side of the road. Council has recently completed road works in Cobah Road, Fiddletown including pavement widening, pavement reconstruction, drainage improvements, and tree pruning. The aim of these works is to improve road user safety, amenity and reduce ongoing maintenance costs.

Following completion of the works, Council has reviewed the existing road delineation concluding that the existing delineation near Northholm Grammar School and Perry Road needs to be extended to the newly reconstructed section of Cobah Road. The wider carriageway provided, generally 6.5m, with a short narrow section of 6.1m, can accommodate the delineation in accordance with Transport for NSW (TfNSW) guidelines.

The Proposal:

- 1) Extend the existing BB line in Cobah Road, north of Perry Rd to past the bend in Cobah Road approx. 100m.
- 2) Install 'S1' separation line with rrpm's along the straight section of Cobah Road approx. 400m. This will join up with the existing BB lines near the school.
- 3) Install Unidirectional hazard markers D4-1-2 near trees at No 77 Cobah Road.

CONSULTATION

The proposal has been developed following request from the community and monitoring of the location. Further consultation is not required as the proposed delineation supports existing road conditions.

CONCLUSION

Formalising the delineation along the newly widened section of Cobah Road will improve driver orientation on the roadway and improve safety. A plan of the proposal is attached.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. Installation of delineation and signage in Cobah Road between Perry Road and Northholm Grammar School in Fiddletown be approved as per plan LTC 31/2023.
