### Background

Following the report of the findings of the 2010 Community Survey study undertaken by Hornsby Shire Council as part of their Community Plan 2010-2020, this addendum to the main report was commissioned due to two additional factors.

1) After the commencement of fieldwork of this study, a slight change to the wording in Question 23 was made, thereby creating potential misinterpretation of the survey results for questions 22 and 23. This affected 24 responses.

2) Since completion of the original study, additional fieldwork has been carried out amongst 104 residents, using these same two questions – thereby increasing the number of respondents who answered these two questions.

N.B. It must be noted however that due to the change in wording of Q.23, all 24 respondents who answered the original script of this question have been removed from these data results.


This addendum to the report is therefore now based on 908 respondents.

Improvements to amenities at local parks and ovals, including lighting, parking and drainage(46%) was the predominant request from residents for Hornsby Shire Council to improve regardless of the age of the respondent (with the exception of those respondents aged 76+ years).

Improvement to local footpaths (40%) was the second most requested service from Council with the replacement of Hornsby Pool (33%) being the third most frequent request.




Q.23 To achieve this improvement in facilities, how much would you be prepared to pay per week in your Council rates?


To pay for these improvements 29% of respondents are prepared to pay \$1.00 per week extra on their rates, with 20% being prepared to pay between \$1.01 and \$1.50 more each week and 24% being prepared to pay between \$1.51 and \$2.00 extra per week. A total of 73% of respondents claiming a willingness to pay some extra amounts per week on their rates in order for council to increase/improve the selected services and amenities.

From the total sample, only 25% of respondents would "prefer not to have these (extra services/improvements) if they had to pay more"
